Invitation to Bid Published for UP-PGH's Cancer Center PPP Project

Manila, June 19, 2023 — The University of the Philippines-Philippine General Hospital has published the Invitation to Bid for interested parties to qualify and bid to design, construct, and equip a 300-bed comprehensive inpatient and outpatient Cancer Center, and operate selected portions, in its Metro Manila campus. The facility will serve both underprivileged and private patients under a 30-year Build-Transfer-Operate Public Private Partnership (PPP).

Bidding is open to all interested parties, whether local or foreign, subject to conditions for qualification under the Bidding Documents, the Constitution, Republic Act No. 6957, as amended by RA 7718 (BOT Law) and its Revised 2022 Implementing Rules and Regulations, and other applicable laws and jurisprudence.

Bidding Documents, including the Instructions to Bidders, the Concession Agreement Term Sheet, and the draft Concession Agreement and its Schedules, will be made available for purchase for a non-refundable fee of Five Hundred Thousand Philippine Pesos (PhP500,000.00).

UP-PGH currently operates at 400 percent capacity for cancer care. With cancer being the country's second leading cause of death, on par with cerebrovascular disease, expanding and improving UP-PGH's cancer infrastructure is a top priority. Under the concession, the private partner will design, finance, construct, and commission the standalone integrated cancer care facility. *For the entire cancer center*, the private partner will procure, maintain, and provide periodic replacement of all medical and non-medical equipment; operate and maintain all non-clinical services, such as facility maintenance and management, cleaning, laundry, and catering; as well as operate parking and retail outlets. *For clinical areas*, the private partner will provide clinical services to paying patients in a dedicated 150-bed private area. A dedicated 150-bed public area will serve underprivileged Filipinos and shall be clinically operated by UP-PGH.

The private partner will be selected through an open, competitive tender through a single-stage process based on the lowest required Annual Payment. The Bid Submission Date is indicatively scheduled for the end of this year.

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
