INVITATION TO CONSIGN VARIOUS DRUGS AND MEDICINES

1. The **PHILIPPINE GENERAL HOSPITAL (PGH)** with its mandate to sustain the demands of public health services and ensure the continuous availability of low cost but high quality essential medical devices/implants, drugs and medicines, and medical supplies, without entailing additional cost or investment from the government, has adopted the "*Consignment System*".
2. The Consignment System is a method wherein consignors place its goods at the PGH (consignee), and the former is being paid by the latter for the actual quantity sold or consumed only, using the proceeds generated from the sale of the consigned goods as recognized by Section 7.3.2, second and third paragraphs, of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184.

The PGH Consignment Committee (PGH-CC) now invites eligible Consignors to submit consignment offers for the consignment of **Various Drugs and Medicines** for one (1) year subject to renewal.

3. Eligibility requirements of the Consignor is contained in the Checklist of Requirements (*please see attached*). Submitted eligibility documents and evaluation of consignment offers/proposals shall be undertaken by the PGH-CC.
4. The complete set of consignment documents may be acquired by the interested Consignor or his/her duly authorized representative from the PGH Consignment Office from **Monday to Friday, except holidays or suspension of work, 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM** upon payment of the participation fee in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) as per PGH Memorandum No. 2018-118.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the [Philippine General Hospital](#), provided that Consignors shall pay the applicable fee for the Consignment Documents not later than the submission of their consignment offer.

5. The PGH-CC will hold the following consignment activities, which shall be open to prospective consignors who availed of the consignment documents:

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TERMS OF REFERENCE

FOR CONSIGNMENT OF VARIOUS DRUGS AND MEDICINES

I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Philippine General Hospital (PGH) is in need of CONSIGNOR/S who is/are willing to consign drugs and medicines for the patients of PGH.

II. CONTRACT DURATION

The Consignment Agreement shall be valid for one (1) year, renewable subject to satisfactory performance to be recommended by the Consignment Committee and approval by the Director.

III. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (Please refer to ANNEX A)

IV. SCOPE OF WORK

1. Ensure the stock availability of consigned drugs and medicines at reasonable prices based on the Consignment List (Please refer to ANNEX B)
2. Ensure that the Quality and Safety Assurance of all consigned drugs and medicines should have gone through the testing and registration process of the Food and Drugs Agency (FDA) and have been issued the proper authorization in the form of Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) pursuant to provision of Republic Act No. 9711, otherwise known as the "Food and Drug Administration Act of 2009" that *"the manufacture, importation, exportation, sale, offering for sale, distribution, transfer, non-consumer use, promotion, advertising or sponsorship of health products without the proper authorization from FDA is prohibited."*
3. Delivery, Acceptance, Inventory and Replenishment
 - 1.1 A Consignment Order for particular drugs and medicines may be issued in-between quarters in order to offset unforeseen exigencies, such as sudden depletion of the particular stock/s as a result of a force majeure or calamities;

- 1.2 The consigned items shall be delivered as scheduled and accepted at the PSD Warehouse; and
- 1.3 Ordering of stock replenishment and processing of unused goods shall be undertaken by the PGH – Consignment Office upon the request of the Department concerned and with the approval of the Director.

V. TERM OF REMITTANCE OF THE SALES PROCEEDS

All payments shall be referred to the payment provision of the Consignment Agreement that is “*the consignee agrees to remit the sales proceeds to the **CONSIGNOR** in fourteen (14) days, after receipt of any of the following, whichever is applicable:*

- (a) *Receipt by the consignee of the funds from the funding agency/ies;*
- (b) *Receipt by the consignee of the patient's payment.”*

VI. PARTICIPATION FEE

A complete set of Consignment Documents may be acquired by interested Consignors from the PGH Consignment Office *upon payment of the participation fee in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) as per Memorandum No. 2018-118.*

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the [Philippine General Hospital](#), provided that Consignors shall pay the applicable fee for the Consignment Documents not later than the submission of their consignment offer.

VII. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The **CONSIGNOR** shall be required to fulfill the following:

1. The **CONSIGNOR** shall be bound to maintain the price of the consigned items during the effectivity of the agreement. It shall guarantee that the final consigned price offer are reasonable and affordable, which shall not be higher than the retail price of generic consigned items for drugs and medicines in the open market and such prices cannot be increased unilaterally. The **CONSIGNOR** may also be guided by the Drug Price Reference Index issued by the Department of Health and other similar laws as the basis for price offering.

No increase can be proposed within the current year but increases can be proposed in the following year during the renewal subject to the recommendation by the PGH-CC and approval by the Director.

In case the price in the open market is lower than the consigned price offer, the PGH has the option to:

- (a) Ask the **CONSIGNOR** to lower its price to the open market price, or
 - (b) Terminate the contract.
- 2. Committed storage of at least one (1) month inventory of consigned items.
 - 3. Committed Stock Availability that it will deliver/supply consigned items within five (5) calendar days upon receipt of order.
 - 4. All deliveries made by the **CONSIGNOR** shall be subject to inspection and/ or testing by the PGH Authorized Representative to the extent practicable and necessary prior to acceptance.
 - 5. Indicate the **brand and packing of the item/s** offered.
 - 6. The brand offered must be **at least five (5) years commercially available in the market from date of the submission of consignment offer**. Proof of this shall be the initial Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) issued by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
 - 7. **Submit the following documents, submission should be per product, with tab and per item number. Two (2) copies for the Valid Certificate of Product Registration and Certificate of Analysis (COA).**
 - a. **Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and Certificate of exclusive/authorized distributorship between the manufacturer and distributor.**

Distributors/suppliers must have certification from their principals that they are the exclusive distributor of the drug products authorized to submit tender for the product on behalf of the principal and that all commitments made by them shall be honored by the principal in case of termination of distributorship agreement.
 - b. **Valid Certificate of Product Registration (CPR)** issued by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
 - **The name of the respective distributor should appear on the submitted CPR of the drug.**

Note: Expired CPRs should be supported with Official Receipt of renewal of application with the Document Tracking log for the CPR from the FDA.
 - c. **Certificate of Analysis (COA)** for the products offered (batch to be delivered if awarded) duly issued by an FDA accredited laboratory (local) and should contain information indicated in monograph of the drug. Sample analyzed must not be expired during the time of consignment. The result of assay submitted must be in the specific brand and should be in the exact dosage formulation of the drug being consigned. In cases where local laboratories are unavailable to perform drug assays, assays done abroad is accepted. The local COA is preferred and given more weight in the evaluation and awarding process.
 - d. **A notarized certificate** that it is the innovator drug (if applicable).
 - e. **Certificate of Good Manufacturing Process (CGMP).**
 - f. **Valid License to Operate (LTO).**
 - g. **A notarized certificate that the offered brand has not been subject to product complaint/product recall** for the past three (3) years.
 - h. **Certificate of Acceptance** from at least three (3) major hospitals issued within the year and should be supported with Sales Invoice (*for new item/brand offered only*).

- i. **A notarized certificate** that there are sufficient stocks for the offered item/s for one (1) year.
8. The offered drug must conform to the latest Philippine Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Administrative Order **governing the generic labeling and packaging requirements**.
 - a. **For all tablets and capsules**
 - i. **All tablets/capsules should be in foil or blister pack. A picture of the blister pack (front and back) should be submitted.**
 - ii. Each individual flap in the tablet or capsule blister pack should be labeled with the generic name and brand.
 - iii. Dosage form and strength of the Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (API) should appear on each unit or every 2 units for products with multiple APIs.
 - iv. Name of drug, lot or batch number and expiry date must appear on every standard blister pack/foil strip and on the container or inner packing. However, if the product is not restricted for dispensing in quantities less than the standard blister pack or foil strip, the batch or lot number and expiry date should appear on each unit.
 - v. Inner label must be the same as the outer label.
 - vi. A complete drug literature/product insert must accompany the product.
9. The following must be complied with specific for **inhalation anesthetics and cytotoxic injectable drugs**.
 - a. **For inhalation anaesthetics**
 - i. Submit **certification from the bidder that inhalation bottle must be with safety sealed cap**, airtight and capable to dispense directly from bottle the possibility of ambient air coming into contact with agent to prevent contamination and spillage.
 - ii. Submit **certification from the bidder that product container or anesthetic agent is shatterproof and transparent for visual check of content**. Container material must ensure stability of the agent to prevent degradation, must not be easy to break.
 - iii. Winning bidder for Sevoflurane shall *provide at least thirty-five (35) vaporizers* on loan and in good working conditions until the validity of the contract.
 - b. **For Cytotoxic Injectable Drugs**
 - i. For cytotoxic injectable drugs, winning bidders are required to *provide Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) and to submit Drug Profile* to the Pharmacy Department per company under the first Purchase Order.
 - ii. Winning bidders for cytotoxic injectable drugs are required to **provide at least three (3) spill kits** per company under the first Purchase Order.
 - iii. For Paclitaxel, a special IV set must be provided per unit of the drug.
10. **New brands offered** shall be subject to further evaluation and shall require the following:
 - a. Validation of the submitted Certificate of Acceptance from at least three (3) major hospitals;
 - b. Justification from end-user/s to validate the acceptance of the good/s offered (to be facilitated by PGH-PSD).
11. Stocks delivered **are subject to random sampling for testing** as to quality and conformity to label. Testing fee at supplier's expense.
12. Stocks with lot #/batch different from the submitted Certificate of Analysis (COA) will be subjected to testing as to quality and conformity to label. Testing fee at supplier's expense.

13. No items shall be offered with expiration dates of less than twenty-four (24) months from the date of delivery.
14. Comply with the security, safety, and PGH house rules related to issuance of medicines and other pharmacy products to patients.
15. All the documents submitted are complete and authentic copies of the original, and all statements and information provided therein are true and correct.

The **CONSIGNOR** will liaise with only five (5) offices and will receive Job orders only from the following:

5. PGH-Consignment Unit – Represented by the Head, **Ms. Anna Leah G. Vinluan**

CHECKLIST OF REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIGNMENT OF VARIOUS DRUGS AND MEDICINES

ENVELOPE NO. 1

Eligibility Documents

1. Appropriate Registration Certificate from the:
 - Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), for corporation
 - Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), for sole proprietorship
 - Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), for cooperatives;
2. Mayor's permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective **CONSIGNOR** is located;
3. Company profile indicating the following
 - 3.1 Company background;
 - 3.2 That the company is a major distributor of drugs and medicines in the Philippines for at least five (5) years; and
 - 3.3 Preferably, with supply chain presence in major areas of the country;
4. List of completed and all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be consigned **using the attached prescribed format** regardless consignment or procurement contract;
5. Sworn and duly notarized statement that the prospective **CONSIGNOR** has not been “*blacklisted*” to participate in biddings by any government agency;
6. The manufacturing company/**CONSIGNOR** shall submit a Certificate of Current Good Manufacturing Practice (CGMP) issued by any entity know or wit the mandate to issue. In case that the prospective **CONSIGNOR** is not a manufacturer, its principal manufacturer's certified true copy of CGMP must be submitted. In case that the CGMP is in foreign language, it shall be officially translated to English language by an appropriate foreign entity;
7. List of Consigned Items that is intended to be consigned **using the attached prescribed format** with the corresponding duly certified copies of Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) issued by the Food and Drug Authority (FDA) or in the absence of CPR, a Certificate of Compassionate Use issued by FDA for consigned item that requires FDA registration. In case a consigned item is non-registrable, a Certificate of Exemption issued by the FDA shall be submitted. Submission should be per product, with tabbings and per item number;

8. Tax Clearance per Executive Order No.398, s. 2005, as finally reviewed and approved by the Bureau of Internal Revenue.
9. Valid License to Operate (LTO) issued by the Food and Drug Administration
10. Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the distributor and manufacturer;
11. Certificate of Analysis (COA) for the products offered (batch to be delivered) duly issued by an FDA accredited laboratory (local) and should contain information indicated in monograph of the drug. Submission should be per product, with tabbings and per item number.

Other Requirement

12. Notarized Letter of Conformity with the Terms of Reference to be printed in the **CONSIGNOR's** letterhead **using the attached prescribed format** together with a **notarized certificate** from the CONSIGNOR to assure that manufacturing defects will be corrected within a given time from receipt of the written notice of the defect by the authorized officer, and that the consigned items supplies/delivered are free from expiration, defects, and/or all the conditions imposed under the contract.z
